※ Make sure to dispose of your garbage by 8:30a.m. on the collection day.
 ※ Do not take it out on the previous day.

Fire hazard waste Put them in the small container at the collection point	Small household appliances Mobile phone, Radio, DVD player, HDD Recorder, Camcorder, Satellite antenna, Boombox, Camera, Car GPS navigation, ETC device, PC (laptop, desktop), Tablet, Computer peripherals, Game Console, Equipment cable, Rice cooker, Microwave oven, Oven, Electric fan, Electric iron, Hair straightener, Hair dryer, Electric heater, etc. ※remove the battery ※Please check our website for more information		Small rechargeable batteries and products using rechargeable battery system (mobile batteries, heated tobacco products, etc.) Li-ion, Ni-Cd, Ni-MH Small rechargeable batteries are batteries that can be recharged and reused, and are used in mobile phones, mobile batteries, laptops, electric assist bicycles, cordless home appliances, etc. Lithium-ion batteries and other items with a recycle mark can be collected at electronics stores.	Products using mercury (Fluorescent tubes, mercury thermometers) In consideration of environmental issues and health hazards, if you have mercury-containing products that used at home, put them in a designated container at the village office (wrap them in paper).	

Items the Village Cannot Collect				Notes
Oversize Garbage Garbage that is too big to fit into the designated garbage bags such as furniture, bicycle, futons and others. Bring them into the Environmental Center Yamato Factory (no fees) yourself, or request a general licensed garbage disposal vendor (fees apply)	Products subject to the Home Appliances Recycling Law TVs, Air conditioners, Washing machines, Clothes dryer, Refrigerators freezers The above home appliances are subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law and must be recycled. Consult the store of purchase. If you do not know where to purchase, request a licensed garbage disposal vendor (fees apply).	Articles difficult to dispose (examples) Fire extinguishers, Drum cans, Tires, Batteries, Chairs and beds with springs inside Consult with the store you purchased the item or request a general licensed garbage disposal vendor (fees apply).	Business-related Garbage Garbage produced through business activities such as restaurants, stores, and factories (ordinary business waste) should be brought into the Environmental Center Yamato Factory by yourself, or request to a general licensed garbage disposal (fees apply for both). One-time large quantity household Garbage If you have an unusual amount of garbage due to reasons such as moving, bring them into the Environmental Center Yamato Factory by yourself (no fees), or request a general licensed garbage disposal vendor (fees apply).	●About products that use fluorocarbons Products that use fluorocarbons (such as refrigerant gas often used in car air conditioner) can't be disposed of as regular garbage. If you want to dispose of it, ask the contractor licensed by the Prefectural Governor vendor to dispose of it. ●Beware of "unlicensed" junk removal companies Do not use unlicensed companies to prevent illegal dumping and improper waste disposal.
